### Cambridge Sculpture Garden on the Grand

Come and enjoy the sculptures in the garden at Grand Avenue South and along the river walk in the heart of downtown Galt. The garden is always open and is the perfect place for a picnic lunch or a family stroll. Admission to the sculpture garden and event participation is free.



### Grand River Pedestrian Bridge

Spanning the Grand River, this new bridge increases connectivity to the river-scape and improves pedestrian and cycling connections within downtown Cambridge, while offering a spectacular view of the downtown core. The walking trails on either side of the river make this an ideal place for a stroll.



### Idea Exchange, Old Post Office

Canada's first digital library, the Idea Exchange's Old Post Office features a creative studio, reading room, discovery center and maker space, and offers exciting opportunities to explore media, STEM learning and technology. Endless hours of learning and fun for the whole family.



### Historic Farmers Market

Operating since 1830, the Cambridge Farmers' Market is one of the oldest markets in Canada. Join us at the market for the fresh local food, homemade crafts, and other unique items. Open on Saturdays year-round from 7-1pm, the Farmer's Market makes for a great family outing and a healthy option for your shopping list.



### Cambridge City Hall

Home of our local government and administration offices, Cambridge City Hall also plays host to many exciting events and festivals throughout the year. The courtyard, positioned between the Farmers Market, Old City Hall, Center for the Arts and the Fire Hall Museum, is a great place to enjoy your home town!



### Fire Hall Museum & Education Centre

Situated in one of the prettiest buildings in the Old Galt section of Cambridge the Fire Hall Museum informs, educates and entertains visitors with vintage fire equipment and various displays that will thrill your family. Admission is free.



### #GaltWings Mural and Photo Stop

A fun public art exhibition, #GaltWings invites your imagination to soar and your dreams to take flight – just like your new life in Cambridge.



### Queen's Square Fountain and Cannon

Queen's Square lies at the heart of old Galt, and offers one of the best views in town. A site so lovely it's been featured in several TV shows, including the Handmaid's Tale, American Gods, Designated Survivor. See if you can find the Queen's Square Cannon, a relic from the Crimean War with a storied history of its own.
